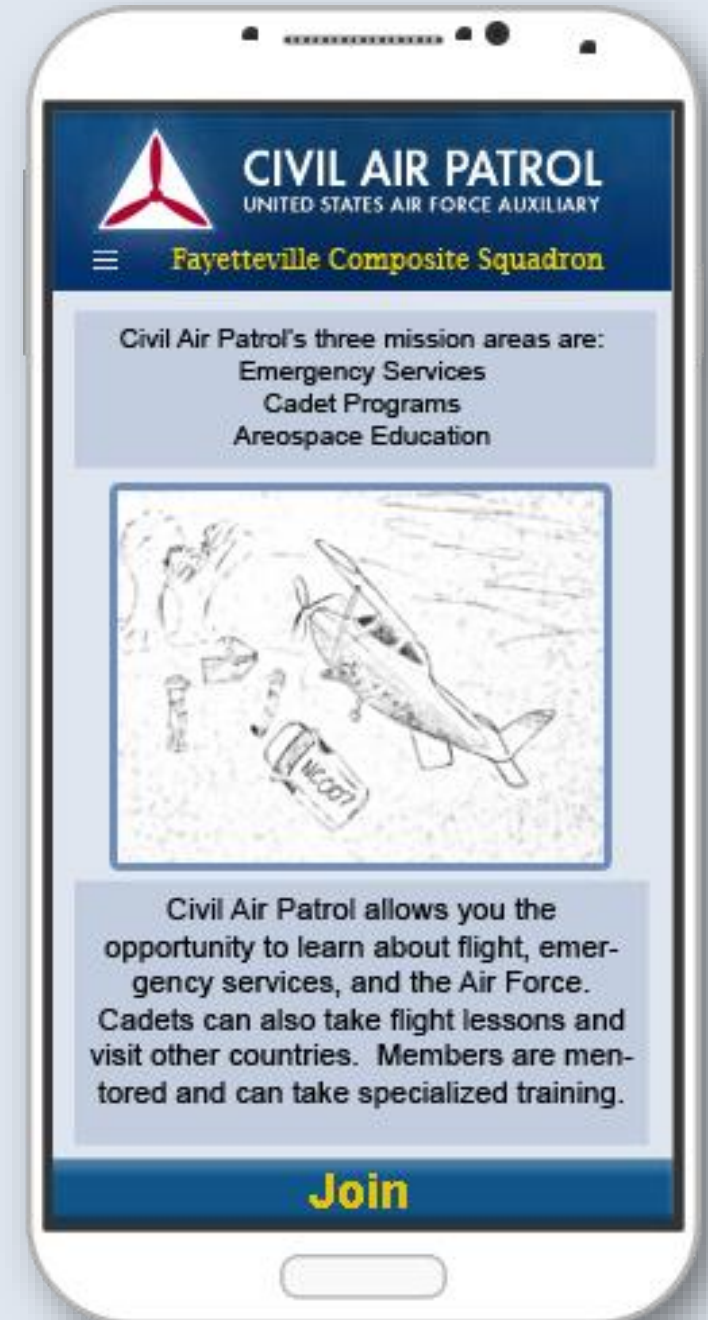
Homepage

The original homepage lacked the content to draw a 12 year old.

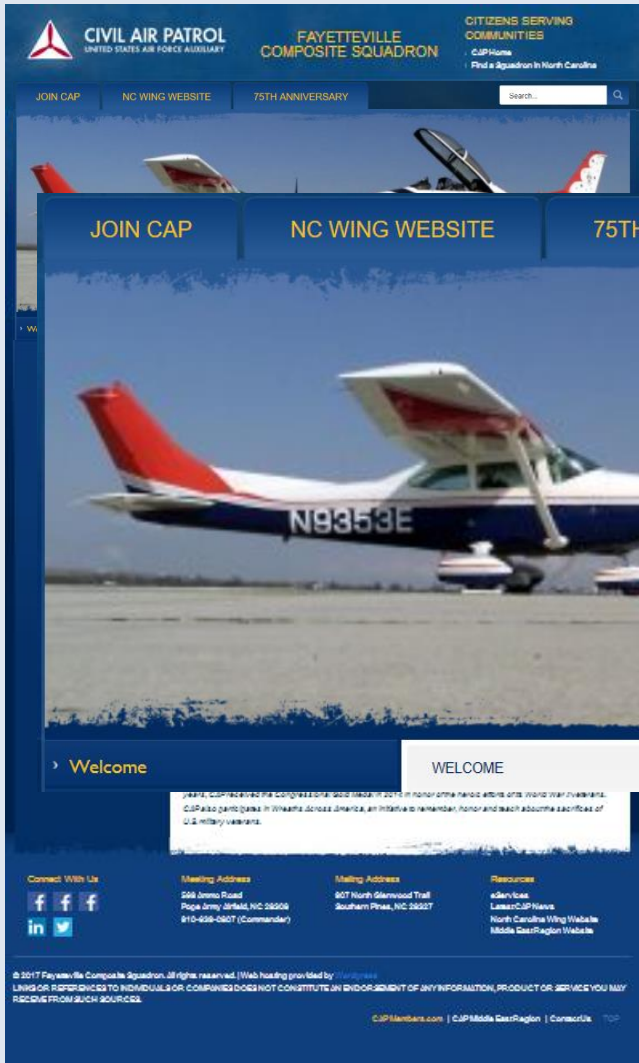
The new homepage clearly shows what Civil Air Patrol does.

It was recommended to have the content geared to the new 12 year olds and not the current members.

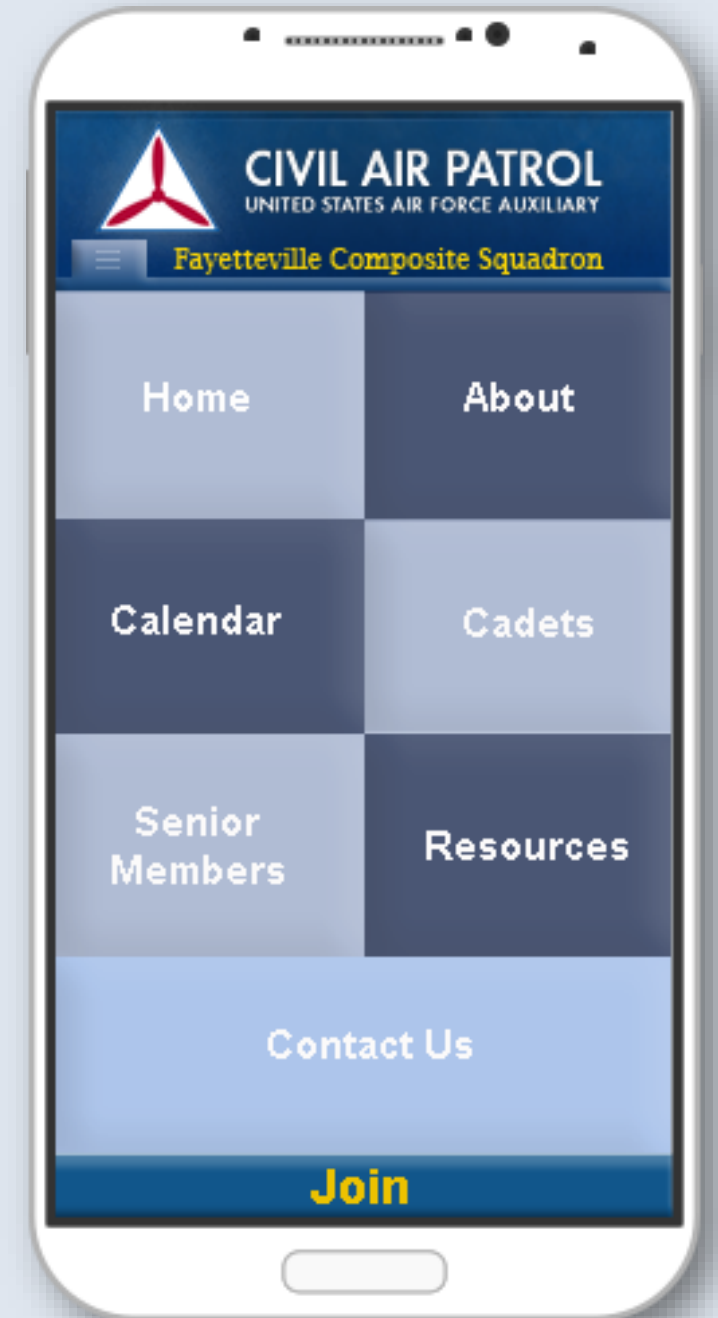

Finding information about specialty tracks is mainly done through the search engine and through a mentor.

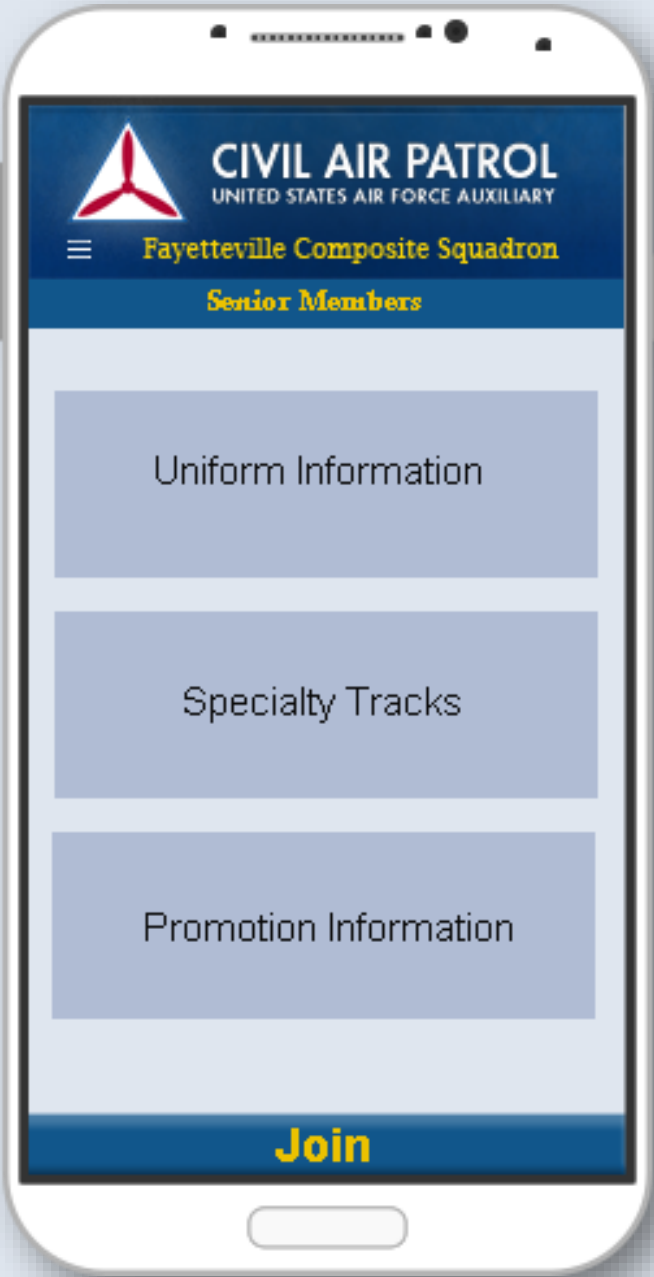
Since the people in the squadron change, it would be helpful to have the information about the specialty tracks in a consolidated spot.
